## NESHAP COMPLIANT WIPE SOLVENT

### Description

TURCO 6898 is a water-white solvent blend formulated to comply with the Aircraft/Aerospace NESHAP. Turco 6898 is designed to replace methyl ethyl ketone and similar solvents that are environmentally unacceptable due to their high composite vapor pressure.

TURCO 6898 is ideal for hand-wipe cleaning of metal surfaces prior to painting, bonding, or application of sealants, and for cleaning bearings or other parts or assemblies.

### Features

TURCO 6898 offers these features:

1. Conforms to Boeing Specifications BMS 11-7G
2. Complies with Aircraft/Aerospace NESHAP
3. Complies with SCAQMD rule 1124
4. Composite VOC vapor pressure of 38 mm Hg.
5. Evaporates rapidly from surfaces.
6. Does not leave surface residue after evaporation.
7. Non-corrosive to all common aircraft alloys.
8. Excellent solvency for oily soils and paint residues.

### Use instructions

TURCO 6898 is used at full strength. Apply to metal surfaces using clean, absorbent cloths. Remove any soil residue with clean cloth. Keep cloth saturated with TURCO 6898. Change cloth frequently for optimum results. Collect used cloths in sealed containers to avoid possibility of spontaneous combustion.

### Disposal information

Dispose of cloths and spent solution per local, state and regional regulations. Refer to TURCO MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET for additional disposal information.

TURCO 6898 contains petroleum solvent, and volatile, flammable alcohols, ketones and esters. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Do not take internally. Use with adequate (equivalent to outdoor) ventilation. Avoid prolonged breathing of fumes.

Protective clothing such as a chemical face shield or goggles and gloves, apron and boots, made from solvent resistant materials should be worn when handling and using this product.

Do not use TURCO 6898 near open flames, cutting torches or welding arcs.

Do not store containers above 50°C or near strong oxidizing agents. Use care in opening drums to avoid spurting of contents.
