



# **TURCO<sup>®</sup> 6719**

## **A NEW NON-EMULSIFYING LIQUID CLEANER**

### **DESCRIPTION:**

TURCO 6719 is a uniquely formulated cleaner designed to remove oily soils but not emulsify the oils.

Disposing of oily wastes generated by parts washing, spills from test stands, machinery cleanup, floor scrubbing, and maintenance shop overhauls places a large load on oil/water separators and waste treatment facilities. TURCO 6719 can reduce the amount of oily water going to separators and waste treatment plants when a spent tank is dumped and recharged. Just allow the used TURCO 6719 cleaning solution to settle and then decant the oil. This also reduces the amount of solid waste generated and enhances resource recovery.

TURCO 6719 is a dark brown liquid with a pleasant citrus odor that is effective on shop soils and greasy surfaces found on equipment, machinery, compressors, pumps, shop carts, tote boxes, machine tools, walls and floors. TURCO 6719 will not harm ferrous or nonferrous alloys, plastics, vinyls, glass or well-bonded paints when used as directed. TURCO 6719 may be applied by mop, sponge, brush, sprayer, high pressure water washers and steam cleaners.

### **FEATURES:**

TURCO 6719 offers these features:

1. Reduces load on oil/water separators
2. Lowers sludge production and solid waste in waste treatment plants
3. Nonflammable, no solvents.
4. Versatile --- can do many jobs

### **USE INSTRUCTIONS:**

**Hand Cleaning:** Use TURCO 6719 at 15 to 25% in warm or hot water. Adjust ratio for soil conditions. Rinse or wipe dry.

**Spray Cleaning:** Use TURCO 6719 at 25 to 50% in warm or cold water. Agitate surface to loosen soils then rinse with clean water.

**High Pressure Water Washing:** Use TURCO 6719 at 0.5% in water for light cleaning or up to 10% in water for heavy soils. Adjust ratio for soil conditions.

**Steam Cleaning:** Use TURCO 6719 at 2% in water, or adjust ratio to meet soil conditions.

**Floor Scrubbing Machines:** Use TURCO 6719 at 15 to 25% in warm water. Adjust dilution ratio for soil conditions.

## **DISPOSAL INFORMATION:**

Dispose of spent solution per local, state and regional regulations. Refer to TURCO MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET for additional disposal information.

TURCO 6719 contains alkaline salts. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Do not take internally. Use with adequate (equivalent to outdoor) ventilation.
